STAYING SAFE DURING YOUR STAY

We know the decision to get vaccinated for COVID-19 is personal. At Family Reconciliation Center, we're more than a house. We're a community. We're also the only free lodging option for everyone coming to Nashville for visitation. We want to keep everyone in our community safe, and we don't want to take away someone's only lodging option because they are medically vulnerable.

That's why, after careful consideration, Family Reconciliation is requiring proof of vaccination for all guests. This includes all adults and all children who are in eligible vaccination groups.

Before guests arrive, each room is also thoroughly sanitized and aerated before you. We do not require guests to wear masks while inside on the property, however those who would feel more comfortable wearing masks while interacting with others are welcome to do so.
